1. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small amount of data in the form of a text file that often includes a unique identifier. Through the web browser, the cookie is sent by the website used to the device used by the user (computer, tablet, phone, etc) and is then stored on its hard disk.

For Microsoft Internet Explorer:

1. Choose the "Tools" menu, then "Internet Options"
2. Click on the tab "Confidentiality"
3. Select the desired level with the cursor

For Mozilla Firefox:

1. Choose the menu "Tools" > "Options"
2. Click on the option "Privacy"
3. Topic "Cookies"

For Chrome:

1. Choose the menu "Edit" > "Preferences"
2. Click on the option "Personal data"
3. Topic "Cookies"

For Safari:

1. Choose the menu "Edit" > "Preferences"
2. Click on the option "Personal data"
3. Topic "Cookies"

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
